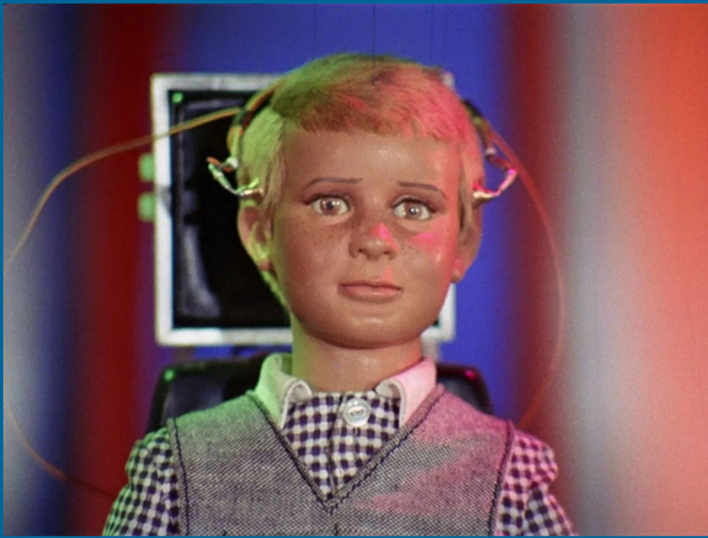


Best Archive Restoration and Preservation Project 2019

Joe 90

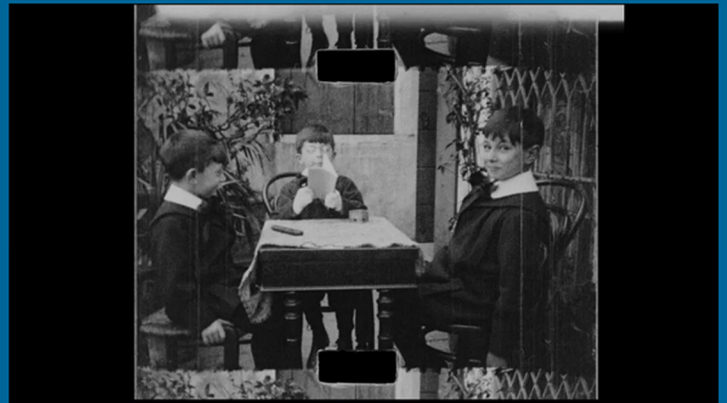
Following the success of Network Distributing Ltd's restoration of *Captain Scarlet*, Gerry Anderson's 1968 Supermarionation series *Joe 90* was scanned from the original A+B negatives and digitally restored, addressing flickering, damage and stabilisation issues.

The Stucky Project

A selection of 15mm films shot by Giancarlo Stucky with Gaumont-Demeny's 'Chrono de Poche,' the first amateur cinematograph, purchased by Stucky in 1900. The restoration process included chemical treatment to allow some of the films to be scanned safely. The digital restoration process was aimed to be least aggressive and respectful of the images.

The Zoo Gang has been carefully colour-graded and digitally restored, taking care to retain the original look. Imperfections such as density/colour flicker, damaged and torn frames and excessive destabilisation have been digital corrected. Network Distributing Ltd have released a Blu-Ray of the restoration through their website.
